HERA provides grants in Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine to purchase equipment for women owned-ventures. With the additional equipment the owner should be able to grow her business and generate additional employment for young women. The venture should have been operating for **at least a year**. Former grantees who are re-starting their business due to conflict may also be considered. Successful recipients from previous years, who have complied with the reporting requirement, may apply for a second grant. HERA particularly encourages women-led ventures in IT, accounting, education, design, engineering and construction.
